Concordia Language Villages, established in 1961, annually welcomes more than 13,000 participants world-wide to its language and culture immersion programs for youth, ages 7 to 18, adults and families. Programs draw participants from all 50 states and 36 countries. The Villages offer one-, two-, and four-week living and learning experiences — some which award high school and college credit; plus year-round, week and weekend programs for school groups, adults and families. Special seminars are available to teachers to learn how to adapt immersion techniques to the classroom setting.

The Villages also are available for private workshop, seminar and conference rentals.
